Row row your boat, twinkle twinkle, 5 little monkeys o Following a point by instructor on where to go/where to put something (sticker game-that k really enjoyed) o Glancing at a peer/tracking peer: pushing peer on dizzy disc, rocking peer on rocker, zoom ball with a peer o **Movement Games:** Ring around the Rosie (peer) o **Ball play:** Rolling it to partner/to peer, catching and throwing o **Receptive instructions with objects:** blow, pop, get the ____, shake o **Isolating finger to point-** popping bubbles o **Vocal imitation:** pop pop (bubbles), weeee (dizzy disc) o Will follow instructions to do an enjoyable activity in context (ie.
